Christmas trees are cut plants - just like a bunch of flowers, only bigger. By bringing them into a warm, dry atmosphere - your house - you are stimulating spring/summer conditions and the plant responds by trying to grow.

- Cut the base this can be done for you at Farmer Gow's. This opens the tree's veins, which will have sealed since being cut in the field.
- Immerse in a bucket of water in a warm (not hot) area of your house or 24 hours – as the tree warms up it will take up a lot of water.
- Transfer into a stand/tree container and water regularly. The tree will take the maximum amount of water in the first 24 hours in the warm but will still continue to take up water for 2-3 weeks - provided it doesn't dry out. If the tree runs out of water you need to re-cut the base again.

Finally ~

- · Keep away from direct heat, ie radiators and fires
- The cooler you can keep it, the longer it will last
